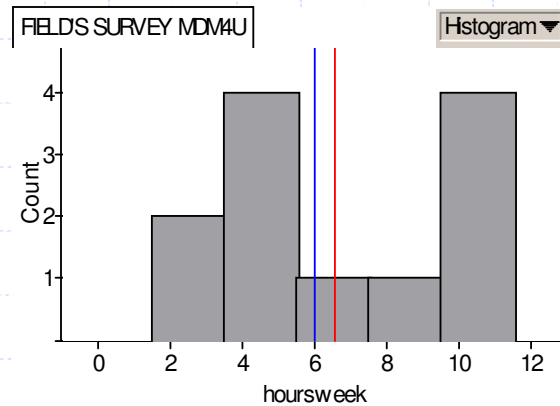
# Number of Hours per Week to Work on Their Own

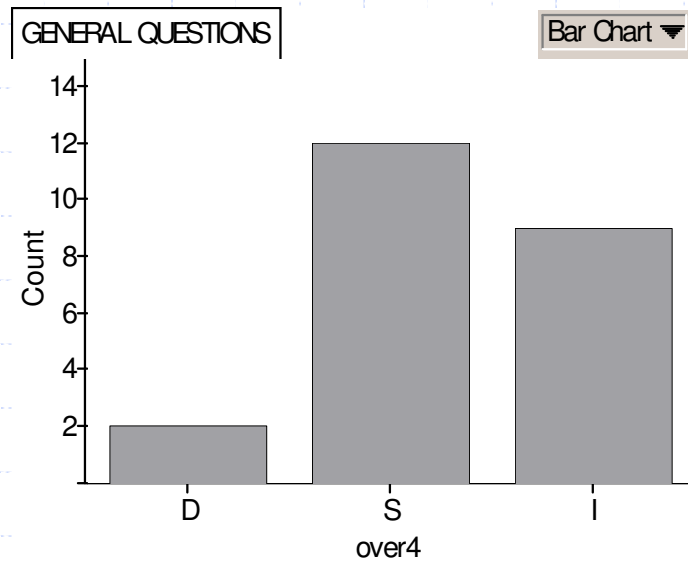


Number of students meeting deadlines



Number of calls from parents

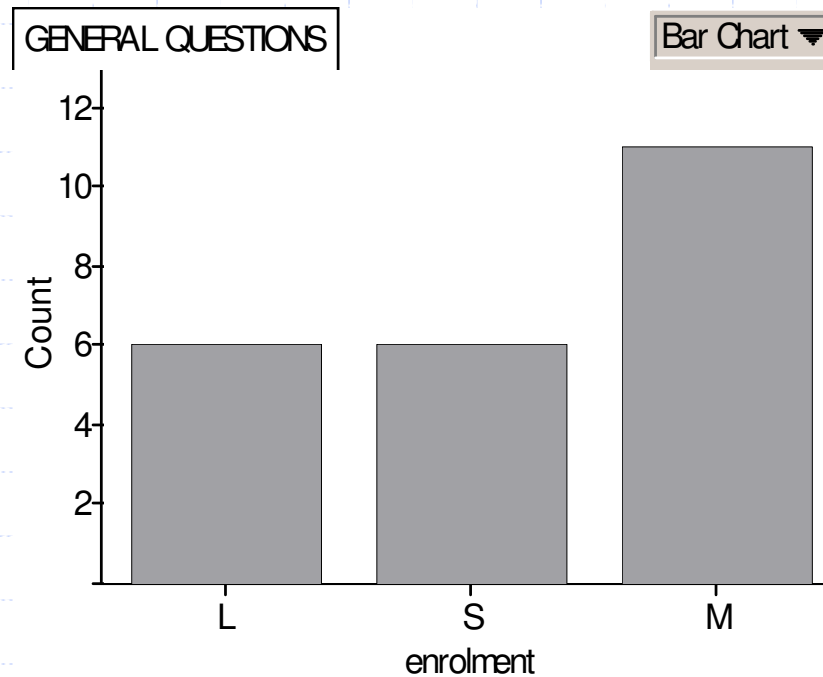
## Number of students completing OSS in 4.5 or 5 years



- Then: the double cohort-students whose grades were not high enough or students who wanted to miss the double cohort year chose an extra semester or year

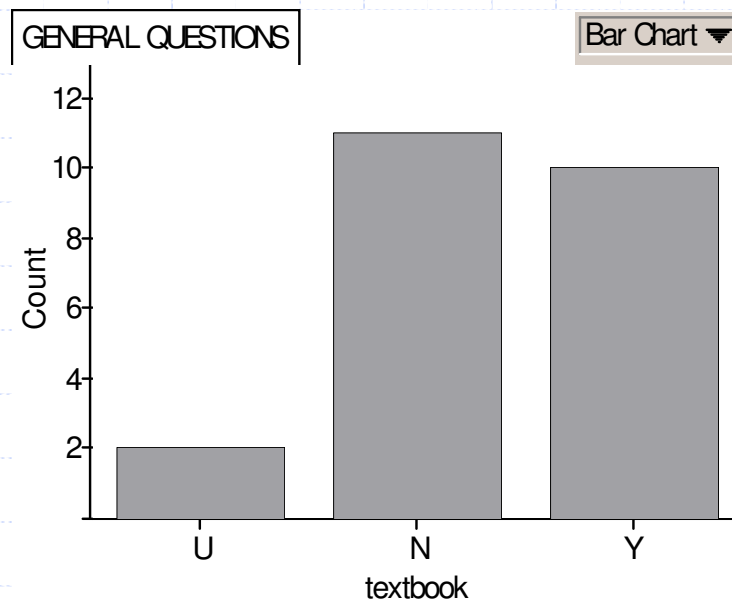
- Now they are choosing 4.5 or 5 years as an option

- We are recommending MCT4C before MCB4U in our Board for students with low grade 11 U/C marks

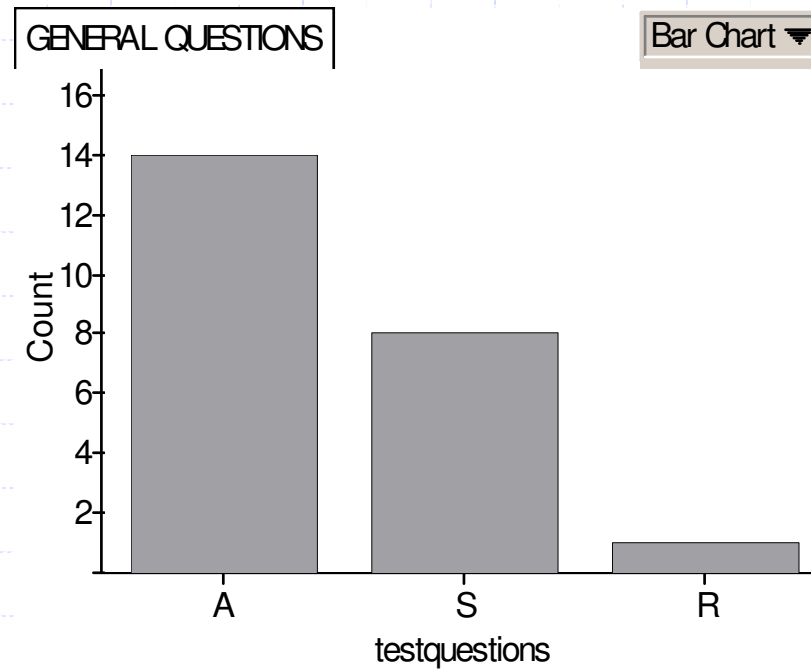


